  - o MAT-120, MAT-127, MAT-130: Score of 46-75
  - o MAT-150, MAT-180, MAT-210: Score of 76-100
- Business Courses:
  - o MAT-140 2.8 GPA or 30+ proctored ALEKS
  - MAT-165 Business Calc 46+ proctored ALEKS
- All students have the right to take the ACCUPLACER and/or the proctored ALEKS test.
- Any person who holds an Associates of Arts, Science or Professional Studies, Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctorate degree (from a regionally accredited institution) should be exempt.
